Robotics, programming and modern technologies are no longer reserved only for large cities. The priority target group of the “Kraśnik – A Safe City of the New Generation” project is the young people of Kraśnik. It is with them in mind that the Kraśnik Development Academy initiative was created.

The initiative includes a wide range of activities dedicated to children and young people from Kraśnik schools, aimed at giving them new opportunities, supporting the development of their interests and helping them build their talents through modern technologies.

Robotics classes, based on well-equipped laboratories in all educational institutions and the Centre for Culture and Promotion, supported by advanced laboratories and technology workshops at the KDA headquarters, will help create an educational and career pathway “from kindergarten to high school”.

A scholarship programme dedicated to the development of passions and interests will provide additional support for students talented in science and technical subjects.

By organizing nationwide and international events for robotics enthusiasts, the Kraśnik Development Academy will become an excellent showcase for Kraśnik – a city that invests in young people and confidently embraces modernity.

The **Kraśnik Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation** is designed to stimulate local economic activity and strengthen entrepreneurial attitudes. The KCEI will cooperate with academic institutions and business support organizations.

The “Local Business Networking” initiative will create opportunities for entrepreneurs to connect and exchange experiences. Events such as “Entrepreneurial Youth” and “Local Entrepreneurship Days”, addressed to young people, will help promote and develop a culture of entrepreneurship.

SAFE KRAŚNIK

A sense of safety is one of our fundamental needs. We must ensure it on the streets, at pedestrian crossings, on the way to school and work, during walks and while returning home in the evening.

Equipped with modern, professional tools, the Municipal Police will become more effective. Better marked pedestrian crossings will make moving around the city safer.

The educational campaign “Aware Residents of Kraśnik – Safe Residents of Kraśnik”, together with a series of training sessions for residents, is intended to raise awareness of potential threats and help prepare the local community to respond to emerging challenges.

“Green Energy for Kraśnik” is the initiative with the largest allocated budget. Most of these funds will go directly to residents through a subsidy programme supporting the installation of renewable energy systems for individual households, as well as grants for housing communities and cooperatives.

Municipal buildings will also be equipped with renewable energy systems. Solar energy is more affordable and environmentally friendly. As a result, electricity and heating costs should decrease, while the air in Kraśnik becomes cleaner.

A modern, quiet bus that runs on time and produces zero emissions means greater comfort for passengers and real benefits for the environment.

The purchase of zero-emission electric buses, the replacement of selected bus shelters and the implementation of a passenger information system are intended to improve travel comfort and encourage residents of Kraśnik to use public transport more often. In this way, while pursuing environmental protection goals, we also contribute to improving the quality of life.
